AGENDA

1. SB 564 CANNELLA Creates the West Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency, specifies the Board composition of the Agency, and adds the Agency to the list of agencies created by statute to manage groundwater that are deemed the exclusive local agencies to comply with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act.
2. SB 872 HALL Allows counties or cities to provide supplemental law enforcement services to private schools, colleges or universities.
3. SB 953 LARA Makes changes to the composition of the Central Basin Municipal Water District's Board of Directors and establishes restrictions on the District's use of sole source contracting.
4. SB 957 HUESO * Allows specified health care districts to use design-build contracting for the construction of a hospital or health facility buildings.
5. SB 958 LARA AND HALL Creates a Citizens Redistricting Commission in Los Angeles County and requires it to adjust the County's supervisorial districts after each decennial census.
6. SB 1000 LEYVA Requires cities and counties to address environmental justice in their general plans.
7. SB 1008 LARA Extends the current CEQA exemption deadline for the Los Angeles Interoperable Regional Communication System (LA-RICS) project for three additional years, from January 1, 2017, to January 1, 2020.

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| 8. | SB 1011 | MENDOZA | Expands the definition of what constitutes a remote interest for purposes of California law governing public officials' conflicts of interest in contracting. |
| 9. | SB 1029 | HERTZBERG | Requires state and local government debt issuers to report information regarding proposed and outstanding debt to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission. |
| 10. | SB 1069 | WIECKOWSKI | Makes a number of changes to state law regarding second units. |
| 11. | SB 1108 | ALLEN | Allows a county or a general law city to establish an independent redistricting commission with the power to adopt district boundaries of the county's or city's legislative body. |
| 12. | SB 1170 | WIECKOWSKI | Prohibits local public agencies, including charter cities, from requiring contractors to develop, or assume responsibility for the completeness and accuracy of, plans to prevent or reduce water pollution or runoff on public works projects. |
| 13. | SB 1172 | HANCOCK * | Repeals the existing granting statute to the City of Albany to eliminate the requirement that the trust lands be used in a manner consistent with the obsolete Waterfront Plan from 1977, and replaces that outdated granting statute with a new grant of public trust lands that is consistent with the City's current waterfront improvement plans. |
| 14. | SB 1179 | VIDAK * | Clarifies in the principal act for public cemetery districts the scope of rights behind an interment right, and establishes a process to allow an owner of an interment right to transfer that right to successors. |
| 15. | SB 1199 | HALL * | Authorizes two existing advertising displays in the City of Inglewood to be considered "on-premise" displays until January 1, 2023. |

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| 16. | SB 1233 | McGUIRE | Establishes the Water Bill Savings Act, which authorizes joint powers authorities (JPAs) to finance water conservation improvements on private property for a customer of a local agency or its publicly owned utility, to repay by charges collected on a water bill. |
| 17. | SB 1262 | PAVLEY AND WIECKOWSKI | Revises requirements that new developments must meet in order to demonstrate that its water supplies are sufficient to include consideration of provisions of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). |
| 18. | SB 1298 | HERTZBERG | Makes numerous changes to the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act. |
| 19. | SB 1340 | WOLK | Requires a local permit for the installation or expansion of automatic irrigation systems for specified residential and nonresidential landscape projects. |
| 20. | SB 1367 | RUNNER AND GALGIANI | Allows local agencies to regulate the sale of certain harmful substances by ordinance. |
| 21. | SB 1374 | LARA | Creates the Lower Los Angeles River Recreation and Park District Act. |
