| 1. | SB 141 | McGUIRE | Clarifies that the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation, and Conservation District is authorized to sell or transfer certain property, and makes several other changes to the District's Act. |
| 2. | SB 184 | GOVERNANCE *
AND FINANCE
COMMITTEE | Enacts the Local Government Omnibus Bill of 2015, which proposes a number of non-controversial changes to existing laws governing the powers and duties of local agencies. |
| 3. | SB 331 | MENDOZA | Requires local agencies that have adopted a Civic Openness in Negotiations (COIN) ordinance for their labor contracts to use a similar process to evaluate, negotiate, and approve specified goods or services contracts valued at \$50,000 or more. |
| 4. | SB 379 | JACKSON | Requires cities and counties to update their safety elements to address climate adaptation and resiliency strategies. |
| 5. | SB 477 | LEYVA | Authorizes qualified mobilehome owners to apply to the State Controller to defer payment of property taxes through the Senior Citizens and Disabled Citizens Property Tax Postponement (PTP) Program. |

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6. ~~SB 485~~ ~~HERNÁNDEZ~~ ~~Authorizes the Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts to acquire, construct, operate, maintain, and furnish facilities to divert, manage, and treat stormwater and dry weather runoff.~~

7. SB 533 PAN Revises and recasts existing law which prohibits a local agency from entering into an agreement with a retailer that would result in the payment of Bradley-Burns local tax proceeds to a retailer if the agreement results in a reduction of revenue that is received by another local agency.
8. SB 562 LARA Allows the City of Long Beach to use a public-private partnership procurement (P3) method to develop a new civic center.
9. ~~SB 710~~ ~~GALGIANI~~ ~~Authorizes California joint powers authorities to issue bonds and enter into loan agreements to finance or refinance projects located outside this state.~~

10. SB 767 DE LEON Authorizes the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA), subject to voter approval, to impose an additional transactions and use tax at a rate of 0.5%.

11. SB 789 WIECKOWSKI Authorizes a local public entity that supplies water at retail or wholesale to impose an excise tax on an excessive user of water at a specified rate, subject to two-thirds voter approval and requires the revenue to be equally distributed between the local public entity and the State Water Resources Control Board.
