1	AB 1825	GORDON AND MAIENSCHEIN	Removes from the definition of "vicious dog" any dog seized from a dog fighting operation.
2.	AB 1889	MULLIN *	Deletes obsolete provisions of law creating the Peninsula Rail Transit District.
3.	AB 2196	LOW *	Makes several changes to the statutes which govern the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority.
4.	AB 2557	SANTIAGO AND BLOOM	Deletes provisions in current law that allow a city or county to adopt an interim emergency ordinance that has the effect of denying approvals needed for the development of projects with a significant component of multifamily housing, and declares that the section of code relating to the ability of a city or county to enact emergency and interim ordinances, as proposed to be amended by the bill, shall apply to charter cities.
5,	AB 2613	ACHADJIAN	Authorizes a special district, subject to specified conditions, to replace a required annual audit with an annual financial compilation and a review of the internal control procedures of the special district.
6.	AB 2618	NAZARIAN	Expands the authority granted to a Mello-Roos community facilities district formed to finance and refinance energy efficiency, water conservation, and renewable energy improvements to privately or publically owned property.
