ADOPTION OF COMMITTEE RULES

1. AB 213 REYES Provides additional revenue to cities annexing territory.
2. AB 411 MARK STONE Authorizes the City of Santa Cruz to use Redevelopment Agency (RDA) bond proceeds for affordable housing and homelessness purposes.
3. AB 631 McCARTY and COOLEY Reduces, from 80% to 67%, the nonweighted voting threshold of the Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) board in order to authorize the detachment of territory from SacRT.
4. AB 891 BURKE Requires cities with a population of 330,000 or more and counties to establish a safe parking program, and requires the Department of General Services to identify surplus state property that is suitable for such programs.
5. AB 931 BOERNER HORVATH Requires state and local boards and commissions with appointed members to have specified percentages of women members.
6. AB 1106 SMITH Eliminates the sunset date on specified elements of the Los Angeles County Homeowner Notification Program.
7. AB 1118 BLANCA RUBIO Requires the Governor's Office of Planning and Research (OPR) to address livability issues for older adults in the General Plan Guidelines (GPG).
