1. SB 765 WIENER Clarifies, revises and expands provisions of SB 35 (Wiener), Chapter 366, Statutes of 2017.
2. SB 828 WIENER Requires a city or county's inventory of land suitable for residential development to meet 125% of its regional housing need allocation for all income levels, and makes a number of changes to the regional housing needs assessment (RHNA) methodology and process.
3. SB 831 WIECKOWSKI Revises, recasts, and expands the law governing accessory dwelling units (ADUs).
4. SB 1018 ALLEN Allows specified local jurisdictions to create a hybrid redistricting commission, allows school districts, community college districts, and special districts to create a redistricting commission, and modifies some of the requirements for serving on a local redistricting commission.
5. SB 1215 HERTZBERG Allows the regional water quality control boards to order provision of service to disadvantaged communities served by onsite wastewater treatment systems.
6. SB 1260 JACKSON Makes various changes related to local fire planning, prescribed fire requirements, and broader fire prevention efforts.
7. SB 1416 McGUIRE Allows, until January 1, 2024, cities and counties to recover fines through nuisance abatement liens and special assessments and requires fines recovered to be used for specified purposes.
