1. AB 570 AGUIAR-CURRY Enacts the Local Government Investment Act to clarify technical implementation issues related to ACA 1 (Aguiar-Curry).
2. AB 707 KALRA Makes changes to the formal bidding threshold for the Santa Clara Valley Water District.
3. AB 992 MULLIN Creates a new exception to a prohibition in the Ralph M. Brown Act (Brown Act) against serial communications by a majority of a local legislative body's members, if they are using social media.
4. AB 1053 DAHLE States the intent of the Legislature to address recommendations in the California State Auditor's audit of the Fallen Leaf Lake (FLL) Community Services District (CSD), and specifies the services that FFL CSD may provide.
5. AB 1095 EDUARDO \*  
GARCIA Alters the terms of office for Desert Healthcare District board members who were appointed when the district expanded, in order to permit them to participate in subsequent elections.
6. AB 1208 TING Extends, until January 1, 2027, a utility user's tax exemption for the consumption of electricity generated by a clean energy resource located on a customer's premises and used solely for the customer or the customer's tenants, and adds to the definition of "clean energy resource" a device or technology used for a renewable electrical storage facility.

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| 7.  | AB 1304 | WALDRON                               | Allows a water district to enter into a contract with a Native American tribe to receive water deliveries from an infrastructure project on tribal lands.  |
| 8.  | AB 1413 | GLORIA                                | Authorizes specified local transportation authorities, which have existing transactions and use tax authority, to levy a transactions and use tax in any portion of its jurisdiction, with voter approval.           |
| 9.  | AB 1730 | GONZALEZ                              | Extends the deadline for the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) to submit its regional transportation plan to the California Transportation Commission and the Department of Transportation by two years. |
| 10. | AB 1822 | COMMITTEE *<br>ON LOCAL<br>GOVERNMENT | Makes several non-controversial changes to the local agency formation commission (LAFCO) statutes which govern local government organization and reorganization.   |
