

- 1) Implementing Proposition 64:
 - Review current ordinances
- 2) Determining whether to regulate or prohibit commercial activities:
 - What works for local jurisdiction
 - Determine specific zones-distance requirements from sensitive uses
- 3) Working with licensing agencies:
 - Local jurisdiction's ordinances must be clear
 - Provide current ordinances to state licensing agencies
 - Delegation of authority for enforcement
- 4) CEQA:
 - Not clear whether ordinance is a "project" - *Union of Medical Marijuana Patients Inc. v. City of San Diego*
 - Can cities rely on programmatic EIR of state agencies?
- 5) Taxation:
 - Appropriate rate
 - Collection method/banking
- 6) Enforcement:
 - Costs of enforcement
 - Availability of grants
- 7) Keeping up with legislation:
 - Numerous bills relating to marijuana in 2017/2018 session
